We support people to recover at their own pace, only moving back into the community when, and if, they are ready – with or without our support. Local GPs provide full medical support and consultants at the nearby Newcraigs hospital are also available.


Situated in an attractive location, with panoramic views of the Caledonian Canal and surrounding mountain ranges, Kinmylies Lodge provides a homely environment, which supports community living.

Teaching essential life skills, such as cooking and budgeting, is important to us. Residents have their own private rooms but share lots of social spaces, including a kitchen where lots of activities take place and everyone is encouraged to develop their confidence.

Social activities are equally important so we regularly hold activities, inside and out of the home, to help improve social skills, including day trips and supporting local community events. We also accommodate individual interests.

We have recently refurbished our home to include self contained flats which are essential in helping people on their journey to living independently.

The home is located in the suburbs of Inverness, with good transport links to the centre of the city. There are also a small number of shops and a chemist within a short walking distance.
