

1. SUPPLIERS: PERSONAL DATA THAT WE PROCESS

Meallmore Ltd respects the privacy of our business partners and are committed to complying with applicable privacy. This Privacy Policy for Suppliers and Potential Suppliers is intended to inform you about how personally identifiable information you submit within your company profile through the Meallmore Ltd supplier registration process will be handled and protected by Meallmore Ltd.

2. Why We Collect and Use Your Personally Identifiable Information

Meallmore Ltd.'s supplier registration process is designed to collect information about your company's qualifications as a potential Meallmore Ltd supplier. When you choose to participate in the Meallmore Ltd supplier registration process you will be asked to provide Meallmore Ltd with information about your company and its capabilities together with certain Personally Identifiable Information such as contact information for key personnel. The Personally Identifiable Information that you provide will be used to assist us in matching your company's capabilities to Meallmore Ltd.'s supplier requirements. This Personally Identifiable Information will also be used to contact and identify you throughout the supplier evaluation process.

3. Disclosures of Your Personally Identifiable Information

3.1 Access to your Personally Identifiable Information will be restricted to Meallmore staff and designated third party agents who have a need to know the specific information in question in order to carry out their responsibilities with regard to Meallmore Ltd.'s procurement process. Your information may also be disclosed to governmental entities pursuant to and in compliance with applicable laws and regulations, or a court order.

3.2 We are not in the business of selling your Personally Identifiable Information to others. We do not reveal Personally Identifiable Information about you to unaffiliated third parties, unless: (1) you request or authorise it; (2) the information is provided to help complete a transaction for you; (3) the information is provided to comply with the law, applicable regulations or court orders, to enforce our Terms of Use or other agreements, or to protect our rights, property or safety or the rights, property or safety of our users or others (e.g., to a consumer reporting agency for fraud protection etc.); or (4) the disclosure is done as part of a purchase, transfer or sale of services or assets (e.g., in the event that substantially all of the assets of an applicable Meallmore Ltd business are acquired by another party). We may also gather aggregated data about you and disclose such aggregated (but not personally identifiable) information to third parties for analysis or other purposes.

4. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

2.1 We will only process your personal data if we have a legitimate (Legitimate Access) and lawful grounds for processing such data. Most commonly, we will use your personal information in the following circumstances:

1. Where we need to perform a contract between us.

2. Where we need to comply with a legal obligation.
3. Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.

5. RIGHT TO WITHDRAW CONSENT

In the limited circumstances where you may have provided your consent to the collection, processing and transfer of your personal information for a specific purpose, you have the right to withdraw your consent for that specific processing at any time.
