We are delighted to be able to welcome visitors back into our homes and look forward to the further careful easing of restrictions, allowing more family and friends of residents to visit.

We have provided more information on our current visitor's policy and what we anticipate will change over the coming months.

Please be aware that this guidance may be subject to change due to local government health guidance and care home outbreak status.

The following guidelines still apply for visitors:

- All visits are to be pre-booked with the care home via the online booking system and visitors are provided a designated timeslot for arrival.
- All designated indoor visitors are subject to Covid-19 screening for each visit and visitors will be offered an LFD test upon arrival.
- All outdoor visitors should arrive and leave at the same time for IPC management.
- All designated visitors must complete a visitor declaration form.
- All visitors are subject to Meallmore screening procedures.
- Outdoor visiting shelters can only accommodate up to 6 visitors from 2 households and the resident. Larger outdoor visiting groups from multiple households will not be able to use these shelters and can arrange to meet in a more open space.
- A maximum of 4 visitors from 2 households will be recommended to attend window visits at any one time to ensure physical distancing can be adhered to.

We understand these last few months have been challenging and some residents may display significant behavioural changes since Level 4 restrictions were implemented.

We ask for your patience and understanding during this time, as our teams work hard to ensure our homes remain as safe as possible for residents and visitors alike.

We ask that all visitors continue to use our handwashing and sanitising stations during their visit.

FRS masks will be provided by the homes to designated indoor visitors in circumstances regarding physical contact and **must** be worn at all times.

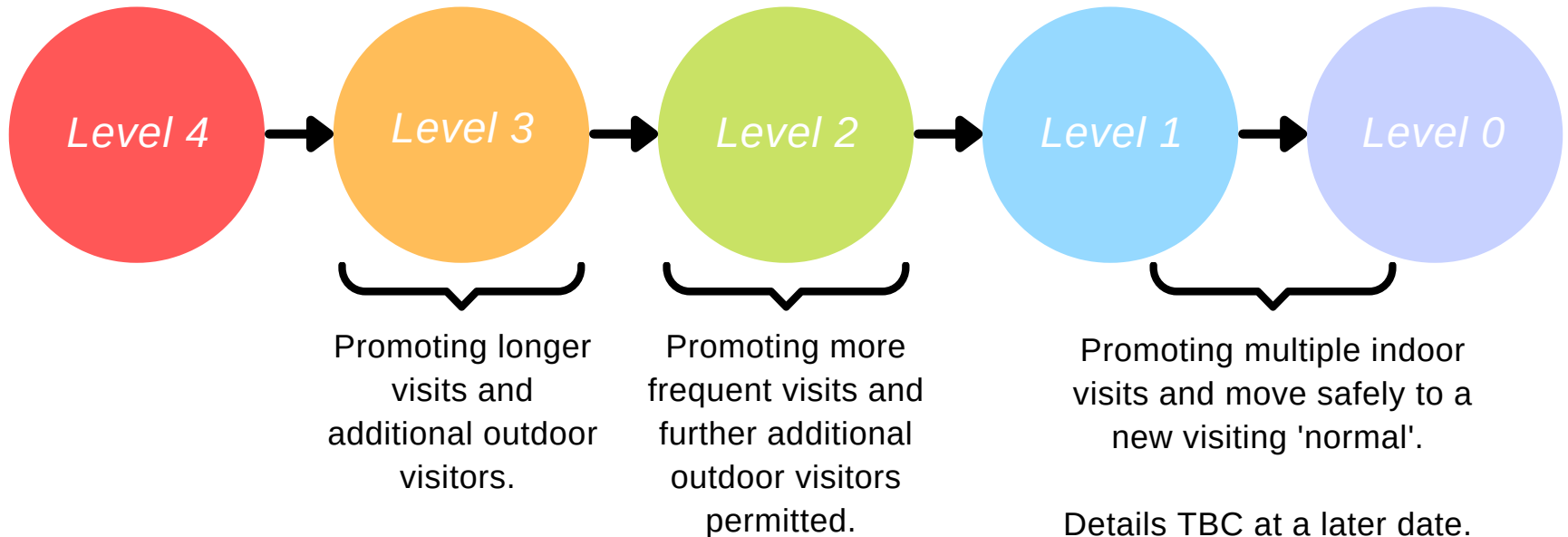


WHAT WILL CHANGE?

We are working in conjunction with the Scottish Government's 'Open with Care' guidance to ensure sensible, safe steps are taken towards the new visiting normal.

As we gradually come out of Level 4 restrictions, we still ask all visitors to follow public health guidance, maintain physical distancing when required and wear a mask for the duration of your visit.

We have provided details about what we anticipate will change as we gradually open our homes to visitors but here are the main changes you can expect.



LEVEL 3

26th April 2021 - 16th May 2021



Indoor Visits

Each resident can have **2 designated visitors** arrange **2 visits per week** (1 person per visit).

Visits can be arranged in communal area or resident bedroom.

Visits will have no time restrictions.



Outdoor Visits

6 visitors from up to 6 different households allowed (assuring physical distancing between households).

2 outdoor visits per week in designated visiting areas.

Recommended visiting time is 1 hour with local flexibility.



Window Visits

4 visitors from 2 different households allowed (assuring physical distancing between households).

Visit frequency and length of time to be agreed locally.



Outings

Walks and outings **outside** care home permitted with any visitor or staff member.

Car trips permitted with **1 designated visitor/staff member**.

To be arranged as part of an organised indoor/outdoor visit.

Length of outing to be agreed locally.

LEVEL 2

17th May 2021 - 6th June 2021



Indoor Visits

Each resident can have **2 designated visitors** arrange **daily visits** (1 person per visit).

Visits can be arranged in communal area or resident bedroom.

Visits will have no time restrictions.



Outdoor Visits

8 visitors from up to 8 different households allowed (assuring physical distancing between households).

2 outdoor visits per week in designated visiting areas.

Recommended visiting time is **1 hour** with local flexibility.



Window Visits

4 visitors from 2 different households allowed (assuring physical distancing between households).

Visit frequency and length of time to be agreed locally.



Outings

Walks and outings **outside** care home permitted with any visitor or staff member.

Car trips permitted with **1 designated visitor/staff member**.

To be arranged as part of an organised indoor/outdoor visit.

Length of outing to be agreed locally.
